the Ithaca Community Choruses!

Our organization, which began life in 1976 as the Ithaca Community Chorus (singular), has grown to include two more choruses, VOICES Multicultural Chorus and the Ithaca Gay Men's Chorus. Though each of our choruses has its own distinct character, all have at least one thing in common: they are open to all singers (in the case of the IGMC, all *male* singers) regardless of ability. For a community the size of Ithaca to offer such a range of choral opportunities to amateurs is pretty remarkable. We invite you to share with us in the enjoyment of our music as a listener and perhaps as a future chorus member.

This season brings you a celebration for Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and a mass for peace recently prominent in the commemoration of the September 11 attacks. From a Hebrew Sacred Service to Broadway tunes, from lively international songs to tight male harmonies, from twenty a capella voices to one hundred singers with full orchestra, our variety reflects the diversity of our community. Our singers are in their early twenties and their early eighties; accomplished performers and folks just discovering they love to sing. Many joined this year; many were founders of their choruses.

The Ithaca Community Choruses participate in the community in many ways beyond our six major concerts. Our informal summer project, Summer Sing, has grown to over 80 participants led by Katie Howell. We sponsor open vocal workshops on diverse topics, recently Thom Baker's "Vocal Gold in the Silver Years" and Deborah Rifkin's "Fun with Aural Skills!." All of our choruses perform in smaller, informal, collaborative environments, from the Ithaca Festival to Porchfest to a major birthday celebration to the Ithaca Community Orchestra to local churches.

Without the support of the Community Arts Partnership, our individual donors, and the advertisers you see in this program, we would never be able to sustain so much momentum. On behalf of our hardworking board and steering committees, our very talented directors and accompanists, and the 230 or so members of the Ithaca Community Choruses, it is my great pleasure to thank everyone who has made this season possible.

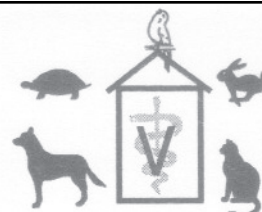

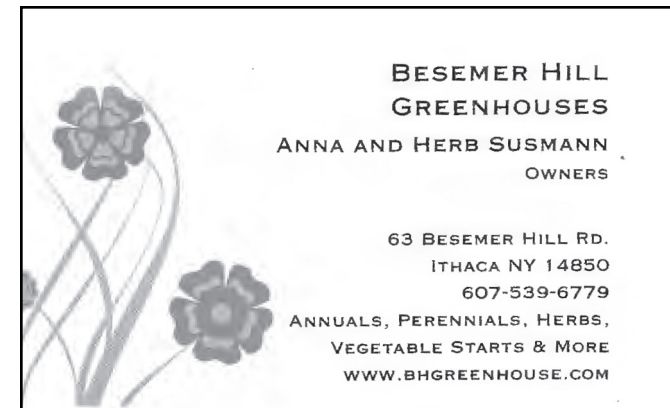

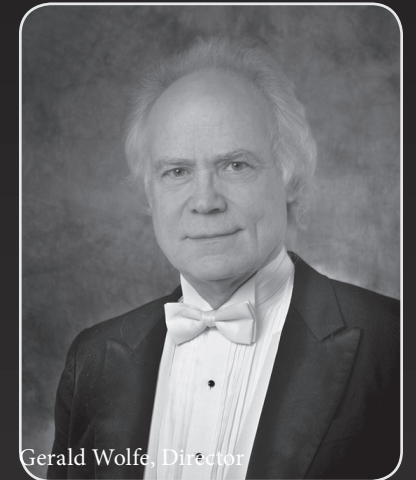

Ithaca Community Chorus & Chamber Singers

Gerald Wolfe graduated from Princeton University and pursued graduate studies in philosophy at Cornell University. In 1975 he founded Ithaca A Cappella and in 1985 the Ithaca Art Ensemble, a sixteen-voice professional vocal ensemble, which in 1988 became the Gerald Wolfe Singers. In 1971 he became the organist at St. Paul's United Methodist Church and in 1982 music director. In 1995 he became parish musician at Grace Episcopal Church, Elmira. He has studied voice with Stanley Snyder and Leslie Bennett; choral directing with Gregg Smith, Paul Christiansen, Robert Shaw, Helmuth Rilling, and Donald Neuen; orchestral conducting with Herbert Garber; and small ensemble singing with The Western Wind.



He became music director of the Ithaca Community Chorus and Chamber Singers in 1990. Since then he has directed the chorus in a wide variety of great choral music, including Bach's Mass in B Minor and St. Matthew Passion, Bloch's Avodath Hakodesh, Brahms' German Requiem, Bruckner's Te Deum, Haydn's Creation, Monteverdi's Vespers, Mozart's Requiem, Mendelssohn's Elijah, Poulenc's Gloria, Part's Te Deum, and Verdi's Requiem. He has conducted Beethoven's Missa Solemnis and Handel's Messiah with the Cayuga Chamber Orchestra. In January 1995, Wolfe led the chorus in performing Rachmaninoff's Vespers in Moscow and St. Petersburg, Russia.

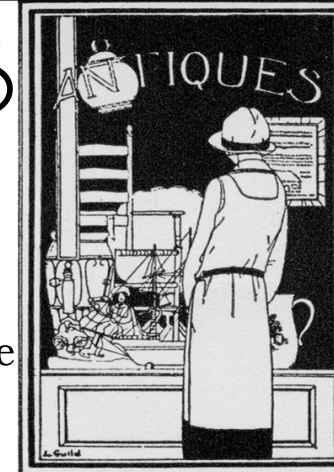

Ithaca Gay Men's Chorus

Thom Baker has directed the Ithaca Gay Men's Chorus since fall 2010. A member of the teaching faculty at The Community School for Music and Arts for seven years, he teaches the Daytime Chorale and coordinates CSMA First Fridays Chamber Music. Baker founded Vocantur, an Ithaca-based chamber chorus that debuted in 2010 with NYS Baroque. Other music directing in Ithaca includes Women's Works performances of Hildegard von Bingen's Ordo Virtutum, Brigadoon and A Day in Hollywood/A Night in the Ukraine with the Veterinary Players, and the Kitchen Theatre production of Stephen Temperley's play Souvenir, which won a SALT award. Born and raised in Iowa, Baker studied music in New York City, singing there and abroad as a soloist and professional choral artist for 17 years. He appeared frequently and recorded with Voices of Ascension, Musica Sacra, the New York Philharmonic, the Bard Music Festival, and AmorArtis, with whom he took several European tours.



The tenor is an avid recitalist, singing music from the Medieval to modern. In November of 2011, he added songs of Wagner and Loy, and will add Mahler's original version of Das Lied von der Erde to his repertoire in the spring of 2012. The spring concert will be held March 3 at 8 pm. Baker continues his long association with the Grammy-nominated cappella ensemble Pomerium, with which he recorded a fifth program in June. In his most recently released recording, he performed as an ensemble member on Bobby McFerrin's April 2010 release, VOCABuLarieS, which garnered three Grammy nominations in 2011.

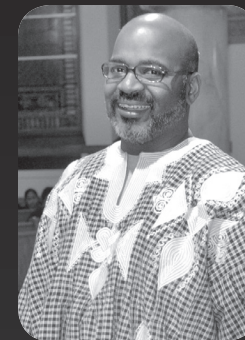

VOICES Multicultural Chorus

Dr. Baruch Whitehead is Associate Professor of Music Education at Ithaca College. An elementary music specialist with the Orff-Schulwerk Process and founder of the Ithaca College Orff certification program, he studied at the Orff Institute in Salzburg, Austria. Dr. Whitehead is founder of the Greater Ithaca Activities Center (GIAC) African dance and drumming ensemble and founder/director of the Syracuse-based gospel choir, Unshackled. He is the 2005 recipient of Ithaca College's Excellence in Service Award. For several years, Dr. Whitehead has been a featured presenter at the International Arts and Humanities Conference in Hawaii for his research on music, learning and diversity. He has made many international presentations, including Making the Connection: African-American and Native American Music in Tenerife, Spain in 2004; Music of the Civil Rights Movement in Winchester, England in 2006; the Russian Mosaic Music Festival in Magnitogorsk, Russia; and upcoming symposia at Yale University and in Greece. As an advocate for the preservation of Gospel music within mainstream musical settings, he has presented multiple workshops on Gospel music and West African drumming. He has taught at the World Music Village in Helsinki, Finland, and been a guest lecturer for the Ahmadu Bello University in Nigeria. Dr. Whitehead travels each summer with students from Ithaca College to the Dagara Music Center in Medie, West Africa, where they study drumming and dance. He is the founder and director of the Dorothy Cotton Jubilee singers, established in 2011. Named for Ithaca resident and civil rights pioneer Dorothy Cotton, the group is dedicated to the preservation of the “Negro spiritual.”



Lorrene Adams, associate music director for VOICES Multicultural Chorus, is a member of the music faculty at Lansing High School. In addition to teaching introductory and advanced-placement music theory, she gives voice lessons, directs the school's Mixed Chorus, Varsity Chorale, and Show Choir, and is music director and conductor for the annual school musical. Prior to coming to Lansing, she held a similar position in Corning, New York.



As an advocate for the proliferation of high-quality choral music for high school students,

Adams has commissioned and premiered choral works from composers Jonathan Santore, Rick Bartlett, and Peter Rothbart. She also performed the New York state premiere of Dominic Argento's *Walden Pond*. She founded the Ithaca Opera Chorus Ensemble and has directed numerous community and church choirs.

A *summa cum laude* graduate of Ithaca College with an M.M. in conducting, Adams encourages collaborations between high school and community groups and believes that choral singing strengthens communities and enhances personal mental, emotional, and physical health. VOICES Multicultural Chorus gives testimony to her beliefs and inspires her each time she steps in front of the group.

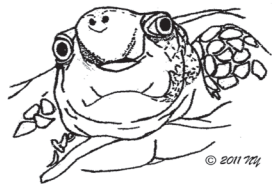
