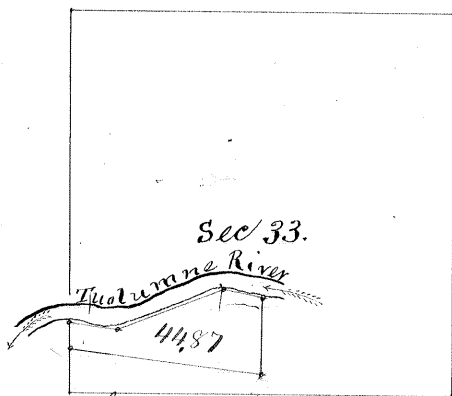

Beginning at Meander post on the West line of Section 33,
thence Run on the U. S. Meander line $S 82^{\circ} E 40.45$ chs.

to quarter Section line thence Run on quarter Section
line $N 34^{\circ} W 16.70$ chs. to the left bank of the Tuolumne River

Meander down Stream Run $N 78^{\circ} W 88.5$ chs, $S 82^{\circ} W 23.70$ chs.

$N 85^{\circ} W 92.5$ chs. to Section line thence Run on Section line
 $S 34^{\circ} E 5.00$ chs to the place of beginning

Run by the true Meridian Magnetic Variation $15^{\circ} 30'$ East
