S. 43° W. 10 chs. S. 55 1/2° W. 9 chs. N. 81° W. 13 chs. N. 22° W. 9 chs. - to a meander post on North and South line between Secs. 32 & 33, thence south with said sec. line 28 chs to right bank of San Joaquin River, thence meander said river up stream on its right bank S. 12 1/2° E. 10.07 chs. S. 19° E. 6.40 chs. S. 65° E. 5.40 chs. N. 33 1/2° E. 12.80 chs. N. 2° E. 14 chs. N. 11 1/2° E. 10 chs. N. 40° E. 5 chs. N. 46 1/2° E. 6.80 chs. N. 54 1/2° E. 6.80 chs. S. 70° E. 8.40 chs to a post on right bank and point of beginning. Run by the true meridian: Magnetic Variation 15° 45' East.
