WE WENT DOWN FAIRLY WELL AND IT WAS QUITE CROWDED BUT THE GROUP WE WERE SUPPOSED TO BE PLAYING WITH (CALLED 'FLACK OFF') DIDN'T TURN UP, WHICH LEFT US IN THE SHIT AS WE WERE SUPPOSED TO BE USING THEIR DRUMS AND BASS AMP, SO WE HAD TO RUSH HOME TO GET OURS.

WHAT SIDES DID YOU TAKE IN THE CRASS VS OI/SPECIAL DUTIES BATTLE LAST YEAR, OR DID YOU THINK IT WAS BORING AND PATHETIC?

WE DIDN'T TAKE ANY SIDES, OR AT LEAST CAROL AND ME DIDN'T, OUR DRUMMER AND BASS PLAYER DIDN'T KNOW ABOUT IT AND PROBABLY COULDN'T CARE LESS ANYWAY. WE PREFER SPECIAL DUTIES TYPE OF MUSIC, BUT CAN'T STAND THE WAY THEY SLAG CRASS DOWN JUST BECAUSE OF DIFFERENT BELIEFS. ALL PUNK BANDS SHOULD STICK TOGETHER.

IS IT HARD TO FIND GIGS DOWN THERE?

IT IS VERY DIFFICULT TO GET GIGS DOWN HERE ESPECIALLY IN REDDITCH BECAUSE IT IS FAIRLY SMALL, AND IN BIRMINGHAM BECAUSE MOST VENUES HAVE BANNED PUNK OR DON'T WANT IT ANYWAY. THE ONLY PLACE THAT PUTS PUNK ON, THE GOLDEN EAGLE IN BRUM, ONLY PUT ON WELL KNOWN BANDS, IT IS ALSO DIFFICULT TO SUPPORT.

YOU ARE CLEARLY AGAINST WAR. DOES THIS MEAN YOU'LL BE VOTING LABOUR IN THE (NOW COME) ELECTION? DO YOU REALLY THINK ANY GOVT. IS ANY DIFFERENT TO ONE ANOTHER?

WE WILL DEFINITELY NOT BE VOTING LABOUR IN THE NEXT ELECTION DESPITE THE ANTI-NUCLEAR POLICIES, THEY ARE FULL OF SHIT SAME AS THE TORIES. I DON'T THINK THAT ANY GOVT. IS DIFFERENT TO ONE ANOTHER, AND THAT ANYTHING WOULD CHANGE IF LABOUR WON. I PERSONALLY WILL BE VOTING FOR THE LIBERAL/SDP ALLIANCE, NOT BECAUSE I AM A GREAT SUPPORTER OF THEM, BUT BECAUSE THEY HAVE NEVER BEEN ELECTED BEFORE. IT'S DOUBTFUL IF THEY'D BE ANY DIFFERENT, BUT IT'S WORTH A TRY.

AND FINALLY, WHAT ARE YOUR FUTURE PLANS, EXCEPTING THE COMPILATION RELEASES MENTIONED IN HAGL NO.1?

OUR FUTURE PLANS ARE TO GET A RECORD CONTRACT, THIS IS OBVIOUSLY THE MAIN THING AND BASICALLY TO GET AS FAR AS POSSIBLE. WE WANT TO EARN ENOUGH MONEY TO MAKE THE GROUP OUR LIVING, THREE OF US ARE ON THE DOLE AND WE'RE PISSED OFF WITH £25 A WEEK. (£25?-IT'S NOT EVEN THAT MATE! - TRAV)

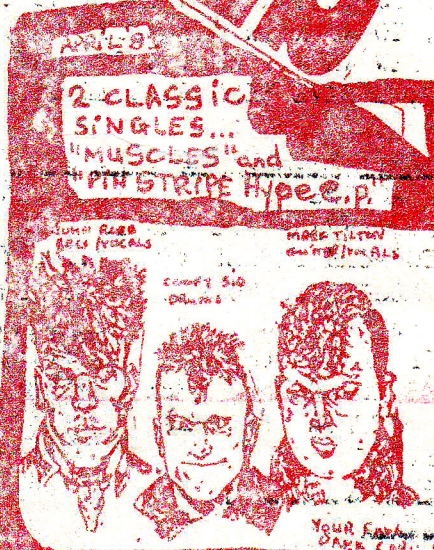

THE BAND'S INFLUENCES RANGE FROM JOY DIVISION/BANSHEES/JOKE TO CRASS AND HAWKWIND. ALTHOUGH THESE ARE THE INFLUENCES, THE BAND IS BEGINNING TO FORM THEIR OWN SOUND.

THE TAPE REVIEWED ELSEWHERE IN THIS ZINE WAS DONE IN ONE DAY AND IS A LITTLE RUSHED, BUT THEY HOPE TO RECORD ANOTHER IN A BETTER STUDIO AND MORE TIME AT THEIR DISPOSAL. ## DESOLATION INTERVIEW

Q : DO YOU GET SLAGGED OFF FOR NOT BEING HARDCORE ENOUGH?

A : HARDCORE! WHAT'S HARDCORE? IT'S JUST A CONVENTION OF THE TIME, A FACTION. REAL PUNKS (AS IN REVOLUTIONARY ANARCHISTS) DON'T THINK OF MY SIDE AND THEIR SIDE BUT OF A UNITED COHESIVE FORCE AGAINST THE OPPRESSORS OF YOUTH, WORKING CLASS AND INDIVIDUALITY. TO WORK IN TERMS OF HARDCORE PUNKS, TRENDY PUNKS, HEAVY PUNKS, SKIN PUNKS, OLD AND NEW WAVE PUNKS, IS TO WORK FOR TRIBALISM, AND AGAINST YOUTH REVOLUTION. BUT YES, WE HAVE BEEN SLAGGED OFF FOR NOT CONFORMING TO THE HARD-CORE CONVENTIONS.

Q : DOES HAVING A DRUM MACHINE MAKE IT HARDER? IS IT EASY TO PROGRAMME?

A : HAVING A DRUM MACHINE MAKES IT EASIER, IN THAT DRUMS ARE CUMBERSOME AND DIFFICULT TO CARRY AROUND, WHEREAS THE MACHINE CAN FIT INTO MY POCKET. ALSO IN THE STUDIO WE WERE ABLE TO WORK FASTER WITH THE LAYING DOWN OF TRACKS. THE DRUM MACHINE TEACHES US AS MUSICIANS TO KEEP TOGETHER. THE ACTUAL PROGRAMMING IS REASONABLY DIFFICULT IN THAT IT REQUIRES A CLASSICAL KNOWLEDGE OF MUSICAL PATTERNS (THANKS TO JOANNE). SHE WORKS OUT THE PATTERNS WE NEED AND I PUNCH THEM IN.

Q : WOULD YOU PREFER TO HAVE A DRUMMER?

A : NO, BUT WE HOPE TO EXPAND OUR PERCUSSION SECTION IN THAT WE HOPE TO GET SOME EXTRA BITS OF A DRUMKIT SUCH AS A SNARE, CYMBALS, AND GET MELANIE TO PLAY THEM WHEN SHE'S NOT ON THE SYNTH.

Q : WHAT KIND OF AUDIENCE HAVE YOU?

A : VARIED, VERY VARIED. WE ATTRACT A NUMBER OF KILLING JOKE TYPE FANS, "BANSHEE" TYPES, SOME SEMI FUTURIST CHARACTERS, NOT MANY SOLID "DISORDER" "EXPLOITED" OR "DISCHARGE" TYPES BUT I HAVE KNOWN SOME. QUITE A FEW NEW WAVE CHARACTERS WHICH CAN'T BE...





## DESOLATION INTERVIEW CONTINUED

...EASILY CATEGORISED. WE GET QUITE A FEW CRASS FANS BUT WHEN WE PLAY, WE PLAY WITH SEVERAL OTHER GROUPS SO WE'RE NOT SURE WHICH PEOPLE HAVE ACTUALLY COME TO SEE US.

Q : HAVE YOU HAD ANY PIECES IN OTHER MAGS?

A : NOT SO FAR (WE'RE A YOUNG BAND) BUT THERE MIGHT BE A FEW IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

Q : HAVE YOU ANY AMBITIONS?

A : YES, LOTS! WE WANT TO BE REASONABLY WELL KNOWN, AND BE ABLE TO GET OUR POLITICAL BELIEFS/MESSAGE ACROSS TO AS MANY PEOPLE AS POSSIBLE, NOT JUST PUNKS, BUT PERHAPS MUMS AND DADS (SOME CHANCE!). WE WANT TO ATTRACT AS MANY DIFFERENT TYPES OF YOUNG PEOPLE AS POSSIBLE AS TO ACHIEVE ANY KIND OF SOCIAL CHANGE.

Q : WHAT'S BEHIND THE LYRICS?

A : WE NEED TO GET ACROSS ALL (OR AS MANY AS POSSIBLE) IN SOCIETY. WE WANT TO PROVOKE THOUGHT, HOPING IT WILL LEAD TO ACTION. CONSIDER THE WORDS TO "CIVIL DISOBEDIENCE", THE FIRST SONG ON THE TAPE :

"DON'T TRUST HEROES, KINGS OR LORDS / DON'T FOLLOW THE CLANS, / FOLLOWING TRIBES  
CREATES A NON-INDIVIDUAL SOCIETY. / THE INDIVIDUAL IS HIS OWN MAN, / DON'T GO  
AGAINST YOUR FEELINGS, / FOLLOWING THEIR CLANS IS KEEPING THE TYCOONS RICH.

Q : ANYTHING TO ADD?

A : YES. WE ARE IN GREAT NEED OF GIGS, WHICH MUST BE SHARED AS WE ARE SHORT OF AMPS. WE CAN PLAY IN EITHER THE CREWE OR NOTTINGHAM AREAS. WE WOULD APPRECIATE IF ANYONE COULD HELP US OUT.

### THE VIBRATORS/RED ALERT N/CLE DINGWALLS MAY 16th 1983

AFTER A DISAPPOINTING TURNOUT FOR THE PREVIOUS WEEK'S ADICTS GIG I THOUGHT THERE WOULDN'T BE THAT MANY HERE TONIGHT BUT I WAS WRONG. IT WAS VIRTUALLY A FULL HOUSE. THERE WAS ALSO A POET SUPPOSED TO BE ON BUT SHE WAS NOWHERE TO BE SEEN. AFTER A WAIT THAT SEEMED LIKE AGES, RED ALERT CAME ON ABOUT 9.30 AND THEY BURST STRAIGHT INTO "TAKE NO PRISONERS". THEY HAD THE NERVE TO DO THE EXTREMELY BORING "I DIE", WHICH, ALTHOUGH HAS GOOD LYRICS IS STILL SHIT. THEN A CHANGE FOR THE BETTER WITH "SHE DON'T CARE", THEIR BEST SONG. "RUSSIANS" WAS SPOILT BY THE MIKE OR PA KNACKING HALF WAY THROUGH. APART FROM THE SONGS ALREADY PUT ONTO VINYL, THERE WAS VERY LITTLE TO OFFER 'CEPT THE LAST 2 SONGS, ONE BEING "BANK OF ENGLAND".

A GOOD NIGHT OUT, AND WORTH THE MONEY.

BY WHAT I CAN MAKE OUT I WOULD SAY IT WAS A CROSS BETWEEN NORMAL PUNK GUITAR(ON SOME OF THE SONGS), JAPAN BORING SYNTHESISED(ON "FREEDOM FIGHTERS" ONLY) CRAP, AND KILLING JOKE TYPE SINGING ALL THE WAY THROUGH. THERE'S NOT MANY SYNTH BANDS HAVE PROTEST LYRICS, BUT THIS APPEARS TO HAVE E.G. "IN THIS SOCIETY", "CIVIL DISOBEDIENCE". ANOTHER THING THAT MAKES THIS DIFFERENT IS THE INCLUSION OF A DRUM MACHINE, WHICH, ALTHOUGH WELL PROGRAMMED, IS NOT AS EFFECTIVE AS THE USUAL DRUMSET.

THE SYNTH IS GOOD ON SOME SONGS BUT ON THE AFOREMENTIONED "FREEDOM FIGHTERS" IT SHOULD HAVE BEEN REMOVED COS IT IS JUST A POINTLESS NOISE. THE GUITAR, IF ANYTHING, REALLY LIFTS THIS TAPE. IT'S POWERFUL AND TUNEFUL AND SHOULD BE PRESENT ALL THE WAY THROUGH THE TAPE. THERE'S A COUPLE OF INTERESTING BASS LINES IN TOO BUT ALL THE INSTRUMENTS SHOULD BE LOUDER TO ADD A BIT POWER AS THE SINGING COMES CLEARLY OVER THE TOP OF EVERYTHING BUT STILL, A VERY GOOD MIX. OK IF YOU LIKE SYNTHS AND A BIT EXPERIMENTATION BUT IF YOU'RE LIKE ME AND YOU FIND MOST OF THAT STUFF BORING, STAY CLEAR. THIS IS STILL BETTER THAN ALL THAT FUTURISTIC SHITE THAT'S ABOUT THOUGH, AND HAS SOME GOOD IDEAS IN THERE. GET IT FOR £1.00 PLUS S.A.E. OR 50p PLUS A BLANK TAPE FROM TREVOR BAMFORD, 28 GRESTY TERRACE, CREWE, CHESHIRE.

## THE FIEND : 5 TRACK DEMO

NO RATING FOR THIS, AS I HAVEN'T HEARD THE ACTUAL TAPE, BUT IF IT'S AS GOOD AS THEIR GIG AT THE TRINITY, IT'S WORTH A BUY. I THINK YOU MAY BE ABLE TO GET IT FROM PHASE IN NEWCASTLE OR SEND A QUID PLUS SAE TO MANIAC, 1 DEVON RD, HEBBURN, TYNE AND WEAR.

UPROAR : "AND THE LORD SAID "LET THERE BE UPROAR"(BEAT-THE-SYSTEM) -3 WEEKS LATER THAN PLANNED COMES THIS SEMI-MASTERPIECE FROM (PROBABLY) THE BEST BAND IN THE NORTH. I KNOW THIS'LL BE EXTREMELY OUT OF DATE BY THE TIME YOU READ THIS, BUT I CAN'T AFFORD MANY LPS THESE DAYS, SO I WRITE ABOUT WHAT I BUY/LEND.

THIS SHOULD HAVE BEEN ONE OF THE BEST LPS EVER, BUT, AS WITH THE EPS, THE PRODUCTION LETS IT DOWN. THE PRODUCTION IS GOOD ONE MINUTE ON SONGS LIKE "UPROAR", "JUST ANOTHER DAY" AND "SOUND OF REALITY", WHILE THE NEXT, ON PARTICULARLY "HELL" THE BACKING VOCALS AND GUITAR THAT MAKE THEM BRILLIANT LIVE, JUST AREN'T CARRIED THROUGH ONTO VINYL. THEREFORE, "HELL" WHICH SHOULD HAVE BEEN THE BEST ON THE L.P., IS SURPASSED BY THOSE SONGS WITH GOOD PRODUCTION. 12 NEWIES TO RECORD HERE(13 IF YOU INCLUDE THE ROCK 'N ROLL FISSTAKE-"VIRGIN-BUBBLE") PLUS BETTER RECORDED VERSIONS OF "NO WAR NO MORE" AND "HAVE A GOOD LAUGH"(HAVEN'T I HEARD THAT SOMEWHERE BEFORE???). ALSO INCLUDED IS A LYRIC SHEET/INSIDE COVER.

OVERALL, VERY GOOD, BUT THEY CAN DO BETTER. HOW ABOUT A LIVE LP SOMEDAY LADS?

DISRUPTERS : "UNREHEARSED WRONGS"(RADICAL CHANGE) ANOTHER CHEAPO FOR 3 QUID AND A BARGAIN. FUNNY THING ABOUT THIS IS THAT ALTHOUGH YOU CAN HEAR EVERYTHING, IT STILL SOUNDS "FLAT". THE DRUMMER SOUNDS AS IF HE HASN'T A SNARE, WHICH IS PROBABLY THE REASON. APART FROM THAT THERE'S NO REASON WHY THE DISRUPTERS SHOULDN'T BE RIDING HIGH IN THE INDIE CHARTS.

ONLY 11 SONGS HERE BUT THE TIME IS MADE UP BY 2 POEMS. INCLUDED ARE VERSIONS OF "ANIMAL FARM"(NOT AS GOOD AS THE SINGLE) AND "NAPALM"(DRAGS ON A BIT, BUT BETTER THAN THE "BULLSHIT" VERSION). BY FAR THE BEST IS THE EXCELLENT "PIGS IN BLUE", WHICH SHOULD GUARANTEE THEM A PLACE IN MENSI'S HEART! SALLY IT'S ONE OF ONLY 3 GOODIES ON SIDE 2, THE FIRST 2 TRACKS SHOWING VERY LITTLE IN THE WAY OF TUNE OR POWER, WHILE "OBSCENE" DOES HAVE A GOOD TUNE BUT ON FIRST LISTEN DOESN'T IMPRESS MUCH.

SIDE 1 IS A DIFFERENT STORY. EVERY TRACK IS GOOD YET NOTHING COMES CLOSE TO THE AFOREMENTIONED "PIGS IN BLUE" BUT BEST CONTENDER IS PROBABLY "ANIMAL FARM".

THE RECORD HAS LOADS OF STRANGE TITLES, BUT THE ENCLOSED LYRIC SHEET GIVES YOU SOME IDEA OF WHAT THEY'RE ABOUT; SONGS LIKE "CABBAGE", "LEPER'S BREAKFAST", "RANDY ANDY MURDERS CHILDREN" AND "INJECT THE CLOWN". LIKE I SAY THOUGH, A BARGAIN. NOW THE QUESTION MUST BE ASKED: HOW MUCH PROFIT ARE LABELS MAKING WHEN THEIR R.R.P. IS £5 FOR LPS? THE ANSWER IS OBVIOUS. A LOT.

I REMEMBER ONCE THE INNER COVER OF THE WALL'S 2nd LP, WHICH SAID "HOME TAPING IS KILLING MUSIC-AND IT'S ILLEGAL". PONDERING WHETHER TO RIP UP THE OFFENDING COVER I THOUGHT TO MYSELF "WELL, IF HOME TAPING'S KILLING MUSIC, I'LL JUST HAVE TO TAPE MY RECORDS AT MY MATE'S HOUSE!". ANYWAY IF MUSIC IS "KILLED", THE REASON WOULD BE "SUICIDE"!

HAGL: DO YOU GET MANY BRITISH PAPERS IN HOLLAND(SOUNDS ETC.)? ARE THEY EXPENSIVE?

GIZ: YES. IT COSTS OVER A QUID FOR THE NME AND ABOUT A QUID FOR SOUNDS.

ZEEK: AND AS FOR THE MELODY MAKER,WELL THEY GIVE THAT AWAY FREE COS NO ONE BUYS IT (HA HA)ONLY JOKING)

HAGL: ARE THERE ANY BRITISH BANDS YOU LIKE?

GIZ: WELL,I LIKE ORANGE JUICE,AZTEC CAMERA,RIP RIG @ PANIC,WEEKEND,PIL,FALL,I.CUTLER.

ZEEK: I'M INTO BONZO LOG BAND,ROBERT PALMER,VIVIAN STANSHALL,UB 40,AND XTC.

HAGL: JUDGING BY YOUR LETTER I RECKON YOU'RE A FUN BAND. ARE YOU?
